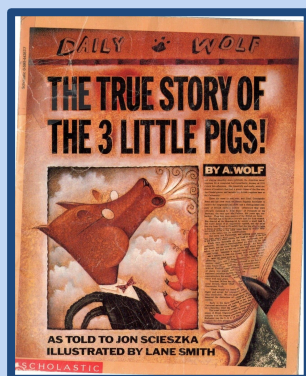
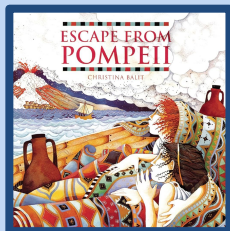


Year 4 Autumn 2 Learning Bulletin

Writing

Our texts will be: Escape From Pompeii, The True Story of the Three Little Pigs

Our writing outcomes will be: Setting description, narrative, interview, news report.

Key Knowledge: apostrophes for singular/plural possession, using conjunctions for sentences with multiple clauses, inverted commas for speech, descriptive devices.

Spelling Rules: /shun/ sounds spelt 'ssion', 'tion', 'cian', 'ough', Y4 common exception words.

Maths: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and Fluency

Key Knowledge:

Week 1: Estimate answers, checking strategies

Week 2: Area What is area? Count squares, make shapes, compare areas

Multiplication & Division, Multiples of 3

Week 3: Multiply and divide by 6 and 9. Learn 3, 6, and 9 times-tables

Week 4: Multiply and divide by 7, Multiply by 1 and 0, Divide a number by 1 and itself, Multiply three numbers

Week 5: Factor pairs, use factor pairs, multiply by 10 and 100, divide by 10

Week 6: Divide by 100, related facts – multiplication and division, informal written methods for multiplication

Week 7: Multiply a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number, multiply a 3-digit number by a 1-digit number.

Fluency: 6 & 9 times tables

Vocabulary

Addition and subtraction:

tens, ones, hundreds, thousands, digit, addition, subtract, exchange, represent, efficient, sum

Area: area, shape, squares, compare

Multiplication and Division:

multiples, multiply, divide, digit, number, written method, factor pairs, times tables

Science - States of matter

Key Knowledge:

- Know that materials can be grouped as solids, liquids or gases based on their properties
- Know that solids keep their shape, liquids flow and take the shape of their container and gases spread to fill space
- Recognise particles in each state are arranged and move differently
- Recognise ways that state changes (e.g. melting, evaporating, freezing, condensing)
- Know that water exists in all three states
- Know how water moves through the water cycle
- Understand that the rate of evaporation is affected by temperature

Key vocabulary: solid, liquid, gas, particles, temperature, degrees celsius, heating, cooling, melting, freezing, evaporation, condensation, water cycle

History - Roman Britain

Key Knowledge:

- The Roman Empire grew to be an empire in 'BCE' and continued to grow into 'CE'
- in 55CE, Britons lived simple lifestyles (revisit the Iron Age)
- Romans tried to invade Britain in 55CE and failed (Julius Caesar)
- The Romans eventually invaded and settled
- The biggest challenges the Romans faced in Britain (including resistance from the Celts)
- Romans left Britain in 410 CE. Britain was a very different place (Roman legacy)

Key Vocabulary: BCE, CE, empire, invade, aqueducts, enslaved people, citizen, senator

PSHE: Celebrating Differences

Key knowledge:

- Know what is special about me and value the ways in which I am unique (including my physical appearance)
- Know that sometimes we make assumptions based on what people look like
- Know what influences me to make assumptions based on how people look
- Know why it is good to accept people for who they are
- Know that sometimes bullying is hard to spot and know what to do if I think it is going on but I'm not sure
- Know why witnesses sometimes join in with bullying and sometimes don't tell

Key vocabulary: character/characteristics, judgement, impressions, appearance, physical features, accept, influence, attitude, power, cyber bullying, troll

RE - What does it mean to be good?

Buddhism and Sikhism

Key Knowledge:

- Buddhists follow The Buddha and his followers.
- Sikhs follow the teachings of the Gurus. (Focus - first & last Guru)
- Buddhists meditate and worship at a temple.
- Sikhs pray at home and in the Gurdwara.
- Describe the 5Ks in Sikhism.
- Buddhists wear saffron robes.

DT - Healthy seasonal pasta salad - Christmas Themed

Key knowledge

- Understand that fruits grow in particular seasons and the benefit of using seasonal food.
- Recognise and understand various ingredients used in pasta salad.
- Revisit and consolidate food safety and hygiene.
- Learn to use a knife safely
- Learn to follow recipe instructions accurately.
- Know how to accurately measure ingredients using grams and millilitres.

Key Vocabulary: seasonal, importing, greenhouse, benefits, farming, vegetables, vitamins, fibre, knife skills, hygiene, ingredients, recipes

Music - This Little Light of Mine

This term, pupils will prepare for the Carol Concert by developing confident two-part singing, learning to project their voices clearly and expressively, and rehearsing with focus and pride. They will refine their ability to follow the conductor, responding to musical cues and dynamic changes to perform with accuracy, expression, and confidence.

French - Quelle-heure est-il?

Key Knowledge:

- Talk about a range of different activities.
- Tell the time.
- Talk about what time you do activities.
- Phonics: i and ch sounds

Example Vocabulary:

Je regarde la télé/un film. J'écoute mes CD/la radio.
Je joue au football/au tennis. Il est... heure(s). Je regarde la télé à cinq heures.

Evaporation experiment

Put the same amounts of water in different containers (wide bowl, narrow bottle, covered, uncovered) and see evaporation rates over days. Compare.

Cloud in a jar - Use a jar, hot water, ice - make a “cloud” inside. Discuss condensation.
