

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL RELATING TO AN APPLICATION FOR A PERFORMANCE LICENCE

Section 22 Entertainment and Performances Children and Young Persons Act 1963

Children (Performances and Activities) (England) Regulations 2014

Regulation 13 permits a child to be absent to take part in a performance, but only under the authority of a licence that has been granted by the Local Authority. Section 37(7) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963 says that a child who is absent to take part in any licensed performance "shall be deemed to be absent with leave". Under the Regulations, such absence must be recorded in the school register as authorised under registration code: C.
